

Directions to the Talladega Coosa River Storage Annex Currently Called TOPTrails (Talladega Outdoor Park Trails)

Directions From South of Talladega, Alabama using Hwy. 21 North Towards Talladega:

- Hwy. 21N all the way through Talladega to the west side of the City of Talladega.
- When you come to McDonalds & Diamond Lil's on the west side of Talladega, you will go passed them. Hwy. 21 N. will turn right and you will go over 2 railroad bridges.
- Go about 1/2 mile past 2nd RR bridge and you will take a left onto Brecon Access Rd. (It will be across Hwy. 21 from Talladega Seed & Feed)
- Go about 1 mile to 4-way at Brecon Access Rd./Broadway/Green Acres. Take a right onto Green Acres Dr.
- Follow the "**Directions From 4-Way Stop**" below.

Directions From I20 East of Oxford, Alabama:

- Take I20 West to the Oxford/Anniston Hwy. 21 Exit 185. Head south on Hwy. 21 toward Talladega.
- Go appr. 18 miles. You will take a right onto Brecon Access Rd. (You will pass thru Munford, past Talladega Creek, Talladega Cycle Sales on left, Cemetery on right, Welcome to Talladega sign on your right and at the top of the next hill will be Brecon Access Rd., take a right.)
- Go about 1 mile to 4-way at Brecon Access Rd./Broadway/Green Acres. Take a right onto Green Acres Dr.
- Follow the "**Directions From 4-Way Stop**" below.

Directions From I20 West of Lincoln, Alabama:

- Take I20 East to the Talladega/Lincoln Hwy. 77 Exit.
- Take a right on Hwy. 77 So. toward Talladega.
- Go appr. 10 miles to Broadway Dr/Ext. and take a left. (This will be about 3/10 of a mile past where the 4-lane ends and just past a Budget Motel, which will be on your left.)
- Take Broadway until it dead ends.
- Take a right and immediate left, as Broadway does a zig-zag.
- Go about 9/10 miles to 6-way stop. Benny's Market will be on your right at stop and a fire station on your left. Go straight thru stop sign past a Victory Gas station. You will still be on Broadway.
- Go about 3/10 mile to 4-way at Brecon Access Rd./Broadway/Green Acres. Go straight thru onto Green Acres Dr.
- Follow the "**Directions From 4-Way Stop**" below.

Directions From 4-Way Stop:

- Green Acres will dead end into Nimitz Dr.
- Take a right onto Nimitz Dr. and go about 8/10 mile to 3rd 4-way stop, which will be Welch Ave. (During this time you will pass by two 4-way stops, a ball park on your right and then to the 3rd 4-way stop at Welch Ave.)
- Take a right onto Welch Ave. (PS. This road will take you all the way to the Complex)
- Welch will curve left and merge with Horne Dr. and you will come to another 4-way stop. Go straight thru.
- You will pass over the bypass construction, passed Talladega Water and Sewer on your right and begin onto a gravel/asphalt road, and you will take the first left into the Brecon Springs property which has been cleared for parking.
- After parking, to enter the Annex property you will go back out to the gravel/asphalt road and take a left. When you come to the crossroads you have already entered the Annex property.
- All the roads run north/south with the exception of the perimeter road and one road splitting the middle going east/west. Remember to never block a roadway and to leave room for wide trucks and trailers to get through. If you camp overnight, make sure to take your trash with you and put out all campfires.

There are about 1000 acres within the chain link fence and another 1800 acres outside this fence. Also remember to wear safety gear and especially helmets when riding, so we do not create a problem within the complex because someone is needlessly hurt due to not wearing proper safety gear. You ride at your own risk. It is not currently being managed, nor does it cost to ride, but please respect the property by putting out campfires, do not build mud holes in main trails, stick to the existing trails, do not ride outside property boundaries, tread lightly and respect others. The property is owned by the Public Park Authority of the Cities of Lincoln and Talladega and development will begin in the 1st Quarter 2011. Beware of many of the mud holes as they can be deep. Rule of thumb is to stay inside the chain link fence on the south and west sides. On all other sides the best rule is to stay within the barbed wire fence as this denotes the property line.
