

The Public Park Authority of the Cities of Lincoln and Talladega, Alabama, who are the owners of the Coosa River Storage Annex, are researching the possibility of using qualified individuals to help in the security of the Annex property located in the Brecon Area of Talladega County, Alabama. The Board has asked if I would broadcast an email to those interested individuals who have or may have had law enforcement and/or security experience, if you wish to contract with them to work as security guards for the property. Volunteers are also wanted to help in the security of the park, if you are interested in volunteering, please place the word "Volunteer" in your response.

The main goal is to stop vandalism, stop people from dumping trash in the park, stop the stealing of metal and other items from the Park, to deter theft and mischief, to ensure campfires are extinguished, to secure the property itself, etc. The gates will not be closed, but each person who has not signed a waiver will be required to sign a waiver before entering. Waivers will only have to be signed once and will be kept on file.
